# Fall 2022 New Jersey High School Math Meltdown

#### Overview

#### What is the New Jersey High School Math Meltdown?

The New Jersey High School Math Meltdown is a 4 day virtual Math competition that begins on October 4, 2022 and ends on October 7, 2022. Registration starts September 1, 2022 and includes a free DimensionU user account from the time of registration through October 10, 2022.

## How is the New Jersey High School Math Meltdown structured?

All participants must register and create a DimensionU Username and Password on the New Jersey High School Math Meltdown Sign-up page to participate. <u>NOTE: ONLY DIMENSIONU USER ACCOUNTS</u> <u>CREATED ON THE SIGN-UP WEB PAGE ARE VALID FOR USE in the New Jersey High School Math</u> <u>Meltdown event.</u> Using an account created elsewhere on the DimensionU website will not be considered valid for use in the competition.

Each day, beginning Tuesday, October 4, 2022 and running through Friday, October 7, 2022, DimensionU will track each participant's highest daily game score in the DimensionU game. ONLY SCORES FROM THE DAILY DESIGNATED GAME WILL COUNT. <u>NO OTHER DIMENSIONU GAME IS ELIGIBLE TO COUNT</u> <u>TOWARDS YOUR HIGHEST GAME SCORE OF THE DAY.</u> Participants may play MELTDOWN on October 4 and 6 as many times as they wish but ONLY the HIGHEST MELTDOWN GAME SCORE from those days will count as their daily score. Participants may play TOWERSTORM on October 5 and 7 as many times as they wish but ONLY the HIGHEST TOWERSTORM GAME SCORE from those days will count as their daily score. DimensionU will aggregate (sum) each participants highest daily game score from each day of the competition to compute a total competition score per participant. A maximum of four (4) scores per participant will be aggregated. In order to obtain four (4) daily scores, each participant must play at least one Meltdown game on October 4 and October 6 and at least one Towerstorm game on October 5 and October 7 during the competition. Scores will only be earned by correctly solving the mathematics problems presented in the designated game. No scores will be awarded in any game if a participant fails to answer at least one (1) mathematics problem correctly in any game instance. Playing daily will provide participants with the best chance to win.

There will be three (3) prizes awarded. The participant who earns the highest total score of the competition will receive a prize valued up to \$500 (actual prize TBD). The participant with the 2<sup>nd</sup> highest total score will receive a prize valued up to \$250.00 (actual prize TBD). The participant with the 3<sup>rd</sup> highest total score will receive a prize valued up to \$125.00 (actual prize TBD). All winners and respective prize distributions are subject to eligibility verification prior to distribution.

## Do I have to register to participate?

Yes. Only students who register and create a DimensionU User account from the New Jersey High School Math Meltdown sign up page will be eligible to participate.

# Do I need to purchase DimensionU Games to participate in the New Jersey High School Math Meltdown?

No, but you must have completed the registration form at <u>https://signup.dimensionu.com/nj-highschool</u>

## Can I play the Web and/or App Versions?

Yes! You can access the DimensionU TOWERSTORM or MELTDOWN games by going to <u>www.dimensionu.com</u> and clicking on "Play Now Online" or installing the mobile apps. The TOWERSTORM and MELTDOWN apps are available for both iOS and Android devices through the respective app stores.

## Do I have to play a specific GAME?

Yes. Only points earned while playing MELTDOWN on October 4 and 6 and only points earned while playing TOWERSTORM on October 5 and 7 will count toward your daily score during the competition.

## Can I play Math or Literacy content?

No. You MUST play Math content for your score to count. DimensionU will lock and set the specific mathematics curriculum for each day of the competition.

## At what Level should I be playing?

While practicing for the Math Meltdown, DimensionU recommends participants select and practice on DimensionU Curriculum of Levels G, H, and ALGEBRA to prepare for the competition. During the competition, DimensionU will set and lock a new daily curriculum for all participants. Topics selected for the competition from within the DimensionU Curriculum Levels will vary from Numbers & Operations,

Algebra, Data Analysis and Probability. Skill-based selections for the competition have been aligned to New Jersey Student Learning Standards (NJSLS) for Mathematics.

#### What are the prizes?

1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners will receive prizes valued at up to \$500, \$250, and \$125, respectively.

#### How will I know if I have won a prize?

The competition leaderboard hosted on the DimensionU Esports website will update in real time with participants daily high scores. Please visit <u>www.dimensionu.com</u> and click the ESPORTS tab to check daily scores and positions on the MATH MELTDOWN LEADERBOARD.

Winners will be notified via the email address (and/or phone number if provided), within 2 business days of the end of the competition for verification and prize distribution details. Eligibility for the competition, **including Age, Grade and enrollment in a New Jersey High School must be verified before prizes are distributed.**
